Egypt, officially known as the Arab Republic of Egypt, is a country located in northeastern Africa, with its Sinai Peninsula also extending into Asia. It is bordered by the Mediterranean Sea to the north, Sudan to the south, Israel to the northeast, and the Red Sea to the east.

Visa

The e-Visa process is easy and can be done online at least 72 hours before arrival.






CURRENCY AND CONNECTIVITY

Mobile networks like Vodafone, Orange, and Etisalat provide widespread connectivity, and eSIM services are available for tourists.

Travelers need to register their SIM cards as per local regulations

Egypt offers a variety of accommodations, from budget options to luxury resorts. Forty under 40 Africa has made accommodation arrangements with the following hotels




SOFITEL NILE EL GEZIRAH (TIER 1) 250 USD

Summer clothing is recommended year-round, but it can get cool in the evenings, especially in desert areas.

Electricity is supplied at 220V, and the plug type used is the European two-pin (Type C) and the three-pin (Type F).
